MEMORIAL DA RESISTÊNCIA

A SITE OF CONSCIENCE

The Memorial da Resistência [Memorial of Resistance] is a museum about the memories of the civil-military dictatorship in Brazil and present-day consequences, showcasing experiences of resistance efforts and the struggle for civil rights, while promoting democracy and citizens' education within society.

As the first museum in the country emphasizing this subject matter, since 2009, the Memorial has been preserving the history of the headquarters of the State Department of Political and Social Order (Deops/SP), which was active for 40+ years and enacted some of the worst political persecutions in Brazilian history.

The Memorial is open to the public, free of charge, with the goal of preserving memories and helping to ensure such past never repeats.

The Memorial of Resistance, for 16 years, has become a reference in preserving political history and promoting human rights.
